BACKGROUND

The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) was initiated at the First Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) for Asia Pacific Region held in Sydney in February 1978. It was officially launched on 7th September 1980 at the 2nd CHOGM in New Delhi, India to signify Malaysia's commitment to South-South Cooperation, particular Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC). The **MTCP** emphasises development of human resources through the provision of training in various areas which is essential for a country's development. These areas include diplomacy and diplomatic practices, economy, good governance, education, tourism, environment, social development, halal industry, safety and security as well as technology, among others. As of 31st December 2022, 37,055 participants from 144 recipient countries have benefited from the various programmes offered under the MTCP. OBJECTIVES OF THE MTCP

- To share development experiences with other developing countries;
- To strengthen bilateral relations between Malaysia and other developing countries;
- To promote South-South Cooperation (SSC), and
- To promote Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC)

FELLOWSHIP / SCHOLARSHIP

Participants will receive support from the Government of Malaysia including:

Accommodation

Participants will be accommodated at a hotel / hostel within the vicinity of the training institute. Participants are strictly not allowed to bring any family members during the course.

Daily Allowance

Participants will be provided with a daily allowance of RM85.00.

Meals

Meals will be provided throughout the duration of the course.

Air Fares

A return flight ticket from the capital city of the recipient country to Kuala Lumpur on economy class is provided for participants.

Course Fees

All course fees are borne by the Government of Malaysia.

Dress Code

Participants are required to dress in formal or office attire throughout the class sessions as well as during official visits to Government Ministries/Agencies.



BACKGROUND OF THE COURSE

This course is designed to provide participants with the opportunities in developing innovative and creative methods in teaching and learning language. The course will also include an exploration into planning, designing and assessing lessons in language teaching based on the current pedagogy and best practices. The course will utilise a project-based approach in training.

- Plan and design activities which contain elements of innovation and creativity.

CRITERIA OF APPLICANTS

This course is intended for primary and secondary school teachers who have a minimum of 5 years working experience and competent in the English language which is essential for them to communicate and engage in the course effectively. Preferably, participants should be between 26 to 50 years of age. Educators at university or institute of higher learning could also be considered for this course.

VISA AND VACCINATION

All participants must enter Malaysia with Visa With Reference (VWR). Participants for the programme will receive a copy of the approval letter from the Institute of Teacher Education International Languages Campus Kuala Lumpur. Participants are required to obtain the VWR stamping from the nearest Embassy/ High Malaysian Commission. **Participants** are required to be vaccinated for Covid-19 prior to arriving in Malaysia. Participants from countries listed in https://www.imi.gov.my/index.php/e n/main-services/visa/visa-

requirement-by-country/ are required to take mandatory vaccination for Yellow Fever at least ten (10) days prior to their departure to Malaysia. Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is required upon landing in Malaysia.

- Passport sized photo (3.5cm x 5cm) (White background)
- Medical Report

All application forms must be written legibly or typewritten, duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of their respective countries and should be submitted only through the diplomatic channel via Malaysian Embassy/ High Commission of Malaysia.

Successful candidates will be duly notified by the Institute of Teacher Education International Languages Campus (IPGKBA) one (1) month before the commencement of the course.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Participants shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner compatible with their **MTCP** responsibilities as participants and abide by the laws, rules and regulations as may be stipulated by the host government in respect of this course.
- The course is held entirely face-toface.


